Checkout Limits:

Almost every item checks out for 28 days

EXCEPTION: 14-day items*

Checkout Limits 2:

New Patrons:

You can check out two (2) items for 28 days, with exception of 14-day items*.

Patrons (Two Months of Membership or Longer):

You can checkout an unlimited number of Library materials and circulating items. This includes books; music and books on audio tape and CDs; videos and DVDs; and magazines.

Fines:

Fines are 10 cents (\$.10) per day per item. There is no grace period for late returns.

Renewals:

Patrons may renew library items twice via the phone, online or in-person -- unless the requested item has a "hold" on it.

Holds:

Patrons may place a hold on all library items, including those checked out to other patrons. When the check-out item is available, patrons are notified by telephone within 24 hours.

Temporary Card:

Patrons with a temporary Library Card may check out two items.

Inter-Library Loan:

Through the Montana Shared Catalog, books or other materials may be borrowed from other libraries. There is no grace period for these items from a Partner Library, and late-return fines are 50 cents (\$.50) per day per item. There is a \$2.00 postage charge for each inter-library loan. Call for possible renewal.
